

## **Additional Privacy Rights for California Residents**

If you are a California resident, California Civil Code Section § 1798.83 permits you to request certain information regarding our disclosure of your personal information to third parties. To make such a request, please write us at: Castle Mortgage Corporation, Attn: Privacy Concern, 5414 Oberlin Drive, Suite 375, San Diego, CA 92121. California Civil Code Section § 1798.100 et al. (also known as the California Consumer Privacy Act or CCPA) mandates the following disclosures to "consumers" (as that term is defined in the CCPA): Castle Mortgage Corporation (CMC) may collect personal information about you that may include the following categories:

- Personal identification numbers (social security, driver license, passport);
- Personal information (date of birth, marital status, number of dependents, demographics);
- Banking and investment information (bank or other financial institution names and account numbers, balances and records);
- Loan and credit information (credit card, auto or student or other loans account numbers, balances, and records);
- Credit reports (Including credit histories and credit scores); and
- Employment and income information (W-2s, W-9s, 1099s, paystubs).

CMC may share your personal information with others as part of the loan evaluation process and, if your loan closes, with loan servicers and investors. CMC may also share your personal information with state and federal regulatory authorities and agencies in accordance with laws and regulations governing our business or to comply with other legal obligations.

CMC does not sell your personal information.

You have a right to request that CMC provide you with the categories of and specific personal information it has collected from you, the categories of sources of that information, the business purpose of collecting personal information, and the categories of third parties with whom CMC shares that information, and CMC must provide that to you upon verifying your identity.

You have a right to request that CMC delete personal information that it has collected about you. However, to the extent that CMC is required to retain that information in order to provide ongoing services to you or to meet other legal or regulatory requirements, CMC is not obligated to delete your personal information.
